

Environmental Management Systems (ISO 14001) Skills Overview

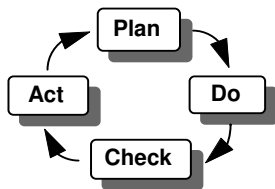
Background

Environmental Management Systems (EMSs) provide a structured approach for delivering continual environmental improvement. EMSs are voluntary and provide the framework in which companies can adopt a systematic approach to managing the environmental impacts of their business activities.



Management system models (including the ISO 14001 Standard) are constructed on the “Plan, Do, Check, Act” model.

Companies can seek assessment and certification to the EMS standards, such as ISO 14001, in order to publicly demonstrate their **environmental commitment** and excellence to their suppliers, customers, shareholders and investors and the general public at large.
